







Courage Hearts – Memory Game

This printable game was created from the world of *The Fear That Found Courage*.

Each card holds a small piece of the story and invites children and families to talk about fear, courage, and the different ways we can feel safe when something seems frightening.

How to play:

1. Print the file twice, double-sided, at actual size – 100% – to create 24 cards and 12 matching pairs.
2. Carefully cut out the cards along the borders.
3. Shuffle them and place them all face down.
4. Each player turns over two cards at a time. When a player finds two matching images, they keep the pair and take another turn.
5. When you find a pair, talk about the image together: Does it remind you of a fear you have felt? What helped your heart find courage?
6. The player who finds the most pairs wins. But the most important part is having the opportunity to talk, be present, and strengthen family bonds.



This is more than a memory game. It is an opportunity for connection.
